Supporting Families of the Fallen on Memorial Day

Memorial Day is the time our nation pauses to honor those who have lost their lives while in service to our country. This day, more than any other, is a testament to our nation's long history to meet any challenge and protect our freedom. This day, and its importance, is etched in the faces of those who represent the living legacy of that service - the families and loved ones left behind. This is the TAPS family.

Since 1994, TAPS has hosted the Annual National Military Survivor Seminar and Good Grief Camp. Held during the Memorial Day weekend, this event connects thousands of surviving loved ones with the support and assistance—administrative, health related, and emotional—that is necessary to regain control of their lives and move forward.

At the Good Grief Camp, young survivors are invited to participate in Littles, Middles or Teen and Young Adult groups to engage with others their own age. Military Mentors are paired with each Good Grief Camper. Military Mentors are active duty service members who have trained to serve as a companion and guide for the weekend, offering careful attention and a military connection that may now be missing from their young lives. Campers participate in fun activities, learn coping skills, establish support systems, and create awareness that they are not alone in their grief.
